The Flowering Wilderness, by WILFRED H. RUSSELL, B.A., 88 pages, 31 illustrations, published by The Leprosy Mission, 7 Bloomsbury Square, London, W.C.1., price 3s.

‘The Flowering Wilderness’, with a foreword by Sir Maurice Hallett, G.C.I.E., K.C.S.I., is a fascinating account of the growth and development of the Faizabad Leprosy Home and Hospital in India, from its formal opening in 1938 to the celebration of its Silver Jubilee.
