ELEP Bulletin, No. 2, December, 1967

ELEP, the Co-ordinating Committee of European Voluntary Agencies engaged in the fight against leprosy, has completed its first year and this bulletin gives a summary of the activities during that year—its contacts with member organisations and with prospective members, its office work and its personnel. A list is included of vacancies for doctors in leprosy work in various parts of the world and of doctors

available for appointment. It is recorded that the Deutsches Aussätzigen-Hilfswerk of Wurzburg, a member of ELEP, celebrated its 10th anniversary in October, 1967, and that the newly-formed Nederlandse Stichting voor Leprobestrijding will shortly seek admittance as a member.
